5-13th November 2019, Diyarbakir, Turkey

“Youth Takes Initiative: Against Bullying” is an exchange project to bring 40 young people from 8 different countries together to get enough knowledge about ‘cyber-bullying’; to share/learn current situations in different countries and its effects in our societies, discuss about how European Institutions and our countries are tackling it and creating social media tools to increase awareness about this issue. In the other hand, we believe that ‘blaming’ new technologies might cause children and young people to have less interest in information and communication technologies (ICT) and it might also cause big problems in the future. Because of this reason, instead of being afraid of ICTs, we would like to improve skills of young people about the internet safety and make them to be conscious users.

Partner Countries: Spain, Italy, Austria, Poland, Greece, Cyprus, Portugal and Turkey (1 group leader + 4 participants from each country).

Travel Expenses: We have budget according to Erasmus + distance calculator rules.
Maximum travel cost for one participant from:

Cyprus and Greece: **275 €**

Italy, Austria, Poland: **360 €**

Spain: **530 €**

Portugal: **820 €**

Travel expenses will be paid according to your travel documents/bills but cannot be paid more than maximum travel costs.
